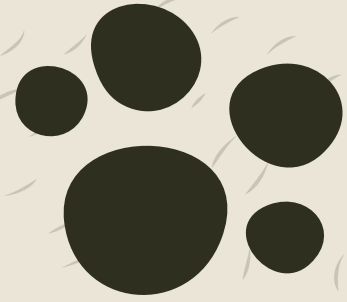


HAPPY POOCH PACT

- For off-lead fun head to our Zoomies Zone, a fenced area you can find next to the road leading to our Meadow Lodges (opening Spring 2024), where dogs can run around and play till their heart's content.
- To make our dogs feel like VIPs (Very Important Pooches) all four-legged guests are treated to a Dog Welcome Pack complete with a ball, tasty treats and doggie poop bags – must-have essentials for adventurous pooches on their travels. Packs also include a snuggly blanket to provide a cosy spot for doggie dozes.
- Muddy paws and dirty coats? It's all part of having fun in our countryside playground. Pooches staying in our lodges are welcome to enjoy a pamper using our outdoor warm water taps.
- Doggie bins are conveniently dotted throughout the resort. Bag it, bin it and keep everything looking tip top.
- Dining with your dog in Cellars Pub? Just ask for a dog bowl and we'll be at your service.
- Some of the activities available across the resort are pretty high-energy, e.g. in the 'Danger Zone'. For the safety and security of pooches (as well as guests), it's best to avoid these areas with doggies in tow.
- The resort is here to be enjoyed by dogs and owners. In return, we ask pooch parents to accept full financial responsibility and liability for personal injury or any property damage caused.
- All of our lodges and many of our restaurants and indoor public areas welcome dogs with open paws. There are a few exceptions though. The Library Bar, the Devon View Restaurant, and the Morning Room are kindly just for guests of the human variety, as are the Manor House rooms and the upstairs bedrooms of the Meadow lodges.
