

DOG CODE OF CONDUCT

One can hardly take a trip to the rolling hills, glistening sunshine and shores of Devon without bringing along their furry companion. We do ask that during their time with us that our dog code of conduct is observed. This is for both the comfort of your pet and our other guests.

- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times throughout the resort
- Dogs are not to be left alone in accommodation, they must remain with you at all times
- Dogs are permitted in all restaurants and indoor public areas with the exception of; Library Bar, Cellar's Restaurant and our Morning Room
- When drinking or dining in our bars and restaurants we request that you do not place your plate on the floor for your dog. Speak to a member of the team who will provide a dog bowl
- Dogs are not allowed on the furniture within accommodation (both beds and seating).
- Dogs are permitted in all lodge categories and estate rooms. Unfortunately we do not allow dogs in bedrooms in the Manor House
- In 2 bedroom lodges, we ask that no dogs are given access to the first floor.
- Dogs are not permitted in the bedrooms
- Dog blankets in the lodge are not to be removed from the resort
- When muddy, please use the heated dog wash outside the lodge to minimise muddy paw prints
- Please clean up any mess left by your dog and place in the dog bins provided throughout the resort; we want to keep our resort squeaky clean for all guests
- Dogs are not permitted on grounds where activities take place
- Please be respectful of other guests, not everyone is fond of dogs
- If your dog isn't a 'good boy', it may result in further action from the team
