- We are happy to provide dog bowls while you are dining if your pet is being treated to a tasty treat, please just ask a member of our team
- We provide a dog blanket in your dog welcome pack to protect the furniture in your room or lodge
- Dogs are invited to stay in any of our lodges and Estate rooms, currently not in the Manor House rooms
- Guests in Lodges can use the warm outdoor tap if needed for a muddy pooch
- Dog waste bins are provided across the resort; please help us in keeping our resort squeaky clean for all guests
- We kindly ask that you avoid taking your dog close to where activities are taking place, for the safety and security of your pet and other guests
- Please be mindful of any guests who may not appreciate that dog's are man's best friend
- As dog parents, we ask that you accept full financial responsibility and liability for personal injury or any property damaged caused
